“Rising to a Higher Standard!”

Dear Parents:

The Department of Public Health has instituted new immunizations requirements for students in the 7th grade this year. These new guidelines were previously required of all students entering 6th grade. They must receive the following:

- Pertussis (Tdap) – 1 dose at least one after 10th birthday
- Varicella (VzV – Chicken Pox) 2 doses – History of disease is no longer accepted
- Meningococcal (MCV4) – 1 dose

If your child has received these shots, please send in a copy so that the Nurse may update their records. She has attached your child’s shot information from the Kid’s Registry. The Kids Registry is a data bank in the City of Philadelphia that your child’s doctor inputs all immunizations that they have given your child. If your child has not received these shots, please schedule an appointment now.

If you cannot get an appointment you can always go to Health District #4, 44th & Haverford Avenue (next to Locke School). They have a Walk-In Immunization clinic. Just show them the shot record that is attached, and they will give your child whatever shots are needed.
